PRE SCHOOL GROUPING PROCEDURE

To assist the teachers with the grouping for the Pre School children and to enable the children to quickly identify with their own teacher, each class is colour coded.

Children are issued with a coloured ribbon and it would be appreciated if you could sew this on to your child's bathers and print the child's name in indelible ink. This will enable the teachers to quickly organise classes.

Please be aware that groups may change; new ribbons can be obtained from the office should this occur.

Swim School hats and bathers are available from the office, however, should your child be reluctant to wear a hat, please ensure long hair is tied back securely.

Preschool classes are a new and exciting experience but, for some children, they can initially seem daunting. Please be assured, our teachers are experienced in dealing with children who are reluctant to part and will gradually coax them into lessons. Children will normally settle into the routine of swimming lessons and can then begin to enjoy the experience and teachers can then build on this, developing confidence and new water skills.
